

## EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY

Curran-Gardner Townships Public Water District is seeking a qualified applicant for the position of water treatment and distribution operations specialist. The successful applicant is required to be a member of the District's union bargaining unit.

The duties of the successful applicant will include but not limited to:

- Performing the operation and maintenance of an IEPA Class A lime softening treatment plant.
- Maintenance of the distribution system including meter reading, installation and repairs of water mains and service lines, flushing, and mowing of well field and tower grounds.
- Performing J.U.L.I.E. locates for the system.
- The ability to operate heavy equipment is a plus.

The District does enforce a drug and alcohol policy. The successful applicant must pass a drug and alcohol test before employment begins and is subject to random testing afterward.

The standard workweek consists of five eight-hour days but can require night, weekend, and holiday work. Overtime at the rate of time and one-half is paid for overtime worked from Monday through Friday as well as Saturday work. Work performed on Sunday and holidays are paid at the rate of double-time.

The District offers thirteen paid holidays, clothing allowance, paid vacation, and sick leave, as well as a retirement program (Illinois Municipal Retirement Fund) Full-time employee's health benefits are covered 100% by the District. An employee may place his/her spouse and/or family on the program with the employee liable for the additional premium cost.

Starting income is based on the schedule specified in the District/Union contract and covers a range from individuals holding no Illinois EPA certification up to the holder of a Class A water certification. There is a 90-day probationary period for all new employees.
